### Analysis of receipts and payments

In the budget presented to the Steering Committee at last year's meeting, we anticipated significant expenditure up to the end of May 2022 on travel and training costs for the Technical Support Function (TSF).

In the event, on-going world-wide circumstances relating to covid travel restrictions meant that these objectives were only partially achieved. However, in the light of the document presented to the PSC-SC in June this year on the TSF, we wish to continue and reinforce these plans.
