Statement, March 2, 2022



To all Members of the INTOSAI Governing Board

Vienna, 2 March 2022

Dear Members of the INTOSAI Governing Board,

During the last days, the General Secretariat of INTOSAI has received a number of letters and messages from INTOSAI members, members of EUROSAI and the INTOSAI Board expressing their strong concerns about the war in Ukraine leading to a serious humanitarian crisis as well as their solidarity for the Accounting member of Ukraine and for the Ukrainian people.

Furthermore, several INTOSAI members have expressed a critical attitude towards the chairmanship held by the SA of the Russian Federation since attacking official letters we have received so far for your information to the members of the Governing Board.

For me in my capacity as Secretary General of INTOSAI, INTOSAI's effectiveness and its function as an international organization is a top priority.

Given the concerns mentioned above, I would like to inform you that this General Secretariat of INTOSAI has held talks with the INTOSAI Chairpersons of the SA of the Russian Federation. Unfortunately, these conversations have not led to any concrete outcome so far.

Since our main goal is to act for the benefit of INTOSAI, I am assured that the General Secretariat does its utmost to ensure that INTOSAI continues to operate in a professional and efficient way.

In the light of the current circumstances, I understand the importance of humanitarian cohesion within the INTOSAI community. Therefore, I would like to invite and ask all of you to express your views about the current situation, and to let me know whether INTOSAI should take any action in this regard. I am looking forward to your answer.

In addition, I also wish to recall the commitment of the UN Sustainable Development Goals, and in particular to SDG 16, which promotes peace, justice and strong institutions.

Statement, March 4, 2022



To all Members of the INTOSAI Governing Board

Vienna, 4 March 2022

Dear Members of the INTOSAI Governing Board,

On Wednesday, 2 March, the General Secretariat of INTOSAI addressed a letter to the members of the Governing Board regarding the war in Ukraine, the humanitarian crisis and the critical attitude among INTOSAI members towards the chairmanship held by the SA of the Russian Federation. The members were asked on how to respond to the current situation. In this regard, the Chairman of the Accounts Chamber of the Russian Federation addressed a letter to the members of the Governing Board where he informed them that he can no longer appropriately exercise his function.

For the General Secretariat, it is a matter of highest priority that INTOSAI's effectiveness and ability to function as an international organization are guaranteed. It expresses its strong concerns on the war in Ukraine and underlines the importance of humanitarian cohesion within the INTOSAI community and recalls the joint commitment of INTOSAI to the UN Sustainable Development Goals, in particular to SDG 16, which promotes for peace, justice and strong institutions.

As a result of the consultations held with the members since Wednesday, the General Secretariat will from now on manage all administrative matters and all contacts between the INTOSAI member SAs and, also in accordance with the First Vice Chair, de facto conduct INTOSAI's operations until the chairmanship is transferred to the SA of Brazil in the framework of the next INCOSAI in November 2022.

Dear members of INTOSAI,

The Brazilian Court of Accounts (TCU), as First-Vice Chair of INTOSAI, would like to join the General Secretariat and other SAs in expressing our solidarity to our colleagues from SAs in Ukraine and to the Ukrainian people. Even though INTOSAI as an organization must adhere to its apolitical mission, the humanitarian aspect of the conflict touches us all. We expect the urgent deescalation of tensions and we are ready to relief, within our capabilities, all humanitarian needs and measures.

As the host of the next INCOSAI, in November 2022, in Rio de Janeiro, we hope that the Congress becomes an event to highlight world peace, understanding and prosperity among nations, as our long tradition of cooperation and inter-institutional relations has always evidenced.

We recognize the difficulties the situation poses to the exercise of the Chairmanship by the Russian Accounts Chambers, and support the solution proposed and fully detailed in the letter addressed to us by the General Secretariat. We stand together with the Secretary-General and all SAs may count upon Brazil to assure that the effective functioning and continuity of INTOSAI activities will be provided. Should there be any specific need for formal representation, the Brazilian Court of Accounts is committed to making it.
